## **OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

**Sub:** Constitution of a Monitoring Committee for reviewing the activities and progress of CSIR-Min. of AYUSH Joint Initiative on Clinical Trials of 4 AYUSH Interventions for COVID-19.

Reference is made to the CSIR-Min. of AYUSH collaboration and recent developments related to the COVID-19 pandemic. CSIR and Min. of AYUSH have agreed to jointly work on four AYUSH interventions for COVID-19 that include AYUSH-64, *Withania somnifera* (Ashwagandha), *Tinospora cordifolia* + *piper longum* (Guduchi + pippali), and *Glycyrhiza glabra* (Yashtimadhu). CSIR constituent laboratory, CSIR-Indian Institute of Intergrative Medicine (CSIR-IIIM), Jammu and Central Council for Research in Ayurveda Sciences (CCRAS), Min. of AYUSH, New Delhi have been identified as the nodal organizations to lead this effort. In this regard a MoU between the CSIR-IIIM and CCRAS was signed on 20 May 2020.

DG, CSIR & Secretary, DSIR and Secretary, Ministry of AYUSH have been pleased to constitute a Monitoring Committee to monitor the project as mentioned in the subject, for achieving the defined objectives in the time and costs projected.

- 2. The Terms of Reference (ToR) of the Monitoring Committee are as follows:
  - (i) To review and examine the progress of the project in conformance with the milestones, targets and objectives set, as contained in the project proposal;
  - (ii) Based on the foregoing, to assess and recommend for:
    - i. modification including dropping in the components of the project, or foreclosing within the overall approved objectives, budget and timeframe;
    - ii. including additional institutional/clinical trial/industrial partners, in the overall interest of the project;



- iii. suitable inter-institutional mechanisms between the Parties for resolution of issues, if any and smooth execution of the identified project activities;
- iv. revising the funding support to any / or all implementing Parties;
- v. revising/extending the project duration, if necessary.
- (iii) To advise on matters related to publications and IPR by the implementing Parties; and
- (iv) Any other matter as referred to by DG, CSIR & Secretary, DSIR and Secretary, Min. of AYUSH.

Chairman of the Monitoring Committee can suggest modifications to the aforesaid composition as per the need co-opt members for specific task and also suggest for external experts on invitation basis.

The Monitoring Committee shall meet as per the requirement of the project, but at least once a month. The meetings of the Monitoring Committee shall be facilitated and convened by the CSIR & Min. of AYUSH jointly.

The expenses of TA/DA and Honorarium of Rs 5000/- per meeting of the non-CSIR and non-CCRAS members will be as per CSIR rules and will be borne jointly by CSIR-IIIM and CCRAS.
